QUESTION ONE (COMPULSORY)

In *Penina Wothaya Wachira vs Methodist University* (Unreported 2018), the High Court held that 'for the petitioner to succeed in review in academic matters, these areas are not disturbed by courts unless the decisions under challenge are constitutionally so fragile and unsustainable.
